

Action Strategy

Freedom 4/24 employs a "strategic partnerships" model to accomplish its mission worldwide. Additionally, we host a variety of awareness and fundraising events including 5K walk/runs, individual event fundraisers, and a black-tie gala to galvanize local communities throughout the United States. Finally, Freedom 4/24 provides direct programming through its prevention education to educate youth, parents, and businesses to prevent exploitation and trafficking before it occurs.

2021 Highlights

- Freedom Gala: We hosted our annual gala and raised over \$134,991 exceeding our \$115,000 goal.
- **Trips:** Even though international travel was cancelled, we were still able to take multiple trips including West Virginia, one to California, and another to a local partner in Roanoke.
- Interns: In 2021, we had 10 interns serve in a variety of roles.
- **Prevention Education:** We hired a Prevention Education Curriculum Developer to start writing our own evidence-based and trauma-informed curriculum.
